\$ export ORACLE\_SID=ORCL

\$ echo & ORACLE\_SID

\$ Salplus / as sysdba

SQL) select name from v\$database.

\$ Salplus

username: scott

password: tiger

SQL) show user

<SCOTT>

1st terminal:-

SQL) shut immediate

SQL) startup restrict;

SQL) select logins from v\$instance;

2nd terminal:-

\$ Salplus

\$ username: scott

password: tiger

as sysdba -

SQL> grant restricted session to jms scott;

at Scott:

\* salpus

username: scott

password: tiger

(connected)

SQL> show user  
scott

as sysdba to Revoke:

SQL> revoke restricted session from scott;

SQL> select logins from v\$instance;

SQL> alter system disable restricted session;

SQL> select logins from v\$instance;

→ Now any user can connect to database
